Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

There is no space provided for unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in this show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award.

## BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

**NOTE:** Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a *Championship* after Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the *Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition*, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at this show. The judge may, at his / her discretion, recall into the ring **UP TO THREE** dogs or bitches to receive **AWARDS OF MERIT**. These Awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

Stud dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the Regular Fee plus the Additional Class fee if the Stud dog is entered in another class. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed.

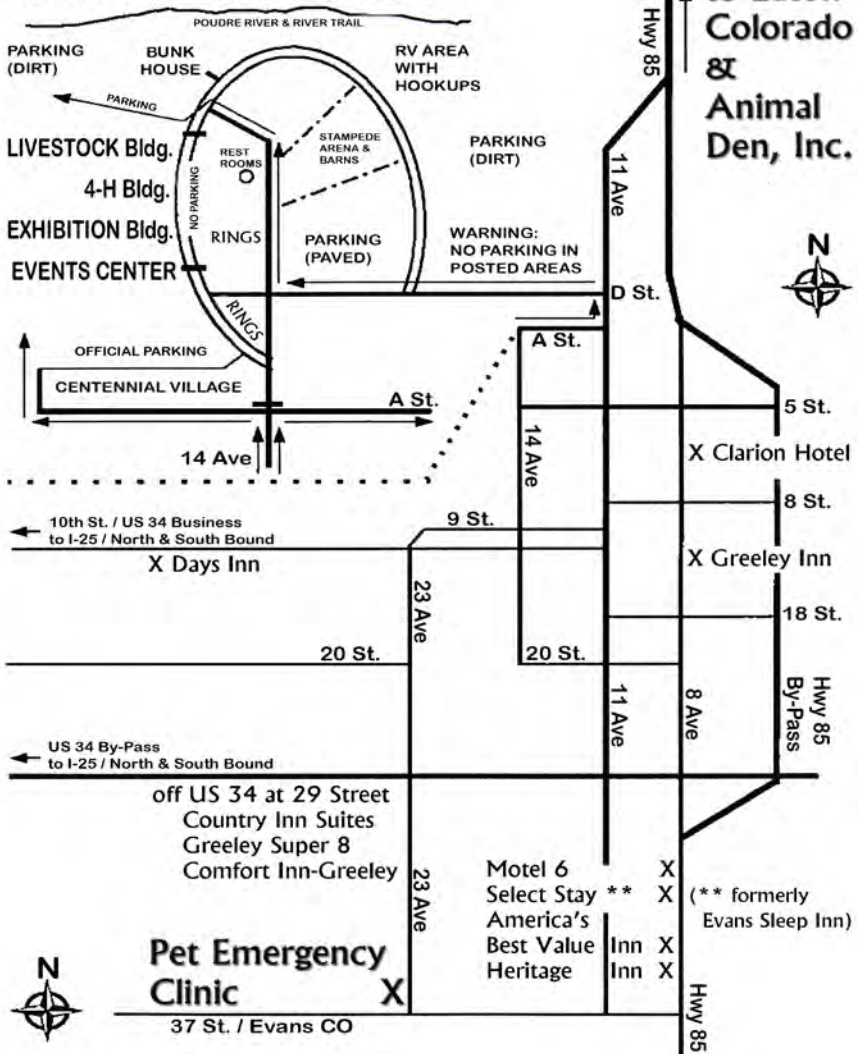
